**Proceedings**


1. The Chairperson Ms. Aditi Misra after ascertaining the quorum commenced the meeting by welcoming all the esteemed members. She also appreciated the contribution of all the member schools towards the success of XVI Annual Conference of GPSC Satchitanand, held on 9 December'17 at Hotel Crown Plaza. She thanked Vice Chairperson Ms. Ujwal Malhotra, and Secretary, Ms. Arti Chopra for their relentless support too.( A copy of summary prepared by Vice Chairperson Ms. Ujwal Malhotra is enclosed for reference)
2. Minutes of the last meeting held on 1st December'17 at Shiv Nadar School, Gurugram, were ratified and approved.
3. The Chairperson solicited feedback from the members about the proceedings of the XVI Annual Conference. The members were happy with the venue chosen, other arrangements including the selection of speakers. Some members expressed the desire to limit the size of panel to not more than four in all. The Chairperson thanked them for their suggestions.
4. The Chairperson proposed to have CBSE'S Center of Excellence organize teacher training workshops for GPSC Schools in the new academic session. The members appreciated the proposal as it would enhance the teaching skills leading to better delivery in schools. Dr. Neelima Prakash, Principal, Lions Public School and Ms. Anuradha Handa, Principal, G D Goenka Public School, were asked to consolidate the choice of subjects for training workshops from the member schools.

The Chairperson nominated an Inspection Committee comprising of Ms. Arti Chopra, Principal, Amity International School, Sector-46, Gurugram and Ms. Dhriti Malhotra, Principal, Manav Rachna School, Sector 46, Gurugram to visit and submit report of DPS, Maruti Kunj, Gurugram, in the next meeting, as the school is seeking membership of GPSC.
6. The Secretary spoke about the Orientation Program on National Deworming Day, under the Chairmanship of Shri. Vinay Pratap Singh, Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram, being held at Amity International School, Sector-46, Gurugram on 7 February'18 and observing 10 February'18 as National Deworming Day. As per the message from DEO's office all schools were asked to collect deworming tablets. She also shared about the meeting she attended, representing GPSC, on 2 February'18, at the DC'S office by District Health & Family Welfare Society, Gurugram regarding MR vaccination campaign of the Govt, a big step towards reducing childhood mortality, addressing birth defects.
7. The Chairperson asked Ms. Charu Maini, Principal, DAV, Sector 49, to share her experiences about the Security Audit conducted by the local administration in her school. Ms. Charu Maini shared the significance of adhering to safety checklist issued by the directorate that includes Surakshit Vahan Policy, POSH at Work Committee, POCSO Committee and School Security Committee etc, just to name a few.
8. The Chairperson also brought to light the tempering of school news, at times by the media in an inappropriate manner, hurting the sentiments of teaching fraternity. On this note, Mr. Vaibhav Kapoor, Principal, Ajanta Public School reiterated that all GPSC members should stand for each other, in any hour of crisis. The Chairperson concluded that parents themselves should stand for the school, affirming the policies of school, where they have reposed their faith and confidence, by sending their children to study.
9. Dr. Indu Khetarpal, Founder member and Treasurer, GPSC, thanked the members for submitting the yearly subscription. She read out the names of following schools who had outstanding dues :
  - Kunsapsskolan School, Gurugram and Ridge Valley School, Gurugram.
  - The schools were requested to make the payments.

The Chairperson requested Secretary & Treasurer to send a note to these schools to expedite the payments latest by 31 March'18, failing which there will be a reconsideration on their membership status.

10. There being no other matter, the meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks, proposed by Ms. Charu Maini, Principal, DAV School, Sector 49, Gurugram to the host school for its warm hospitality and sumptuous repast.
