Proceedings:

1. The members were welcomed by the Chairperson Ms. Aparna Erry and the meeting commenced at 3.00 pm after ascertaining the forum.
2. The Chairperson announced that the main theme of the GPSC conference to be held on 8th February 2020 will be '*Competencies of 21st century*' and the subheadings are as follows:
 - Creative Thinking – Thinking out of the Box
 - Collaborations through networking
 - Communication – Connection before correction
 - Critical Thinking
3. There will be an inauguration ceremony followed by panel discussion and a valedictory ceremony at the end of the program.
4. The Chairperson recommended the name of Prof. Manish Jain, from IIT Gandhinagar as the main speaker for the session on '*Creative thinking*'.

It was also suggested that since the session taken by Prof. Manish Jain at National Sahodaya Convention was exceptionally good, he could take Experiential learning session, a day prior for the teachers of GPSC schools too, so that Experiential Learning could reach our classrooms. As decided in the Executive Committee Meeting, member schools could send two to three teachers to the venue DAV School, Sector-14, Gurugram and pay at the rate of Rs 1000/- per teacher attendee. All the members present welcomed and appreciated the suggestion. A separate notice to this affect shall follow.

6. It was further announced by Chairperson that the cultural program is to be held during the Inauguration and Valedictory ceremony for which the following directives need to be followed:

 - B. Suggested names of teachers for Anchoring the Conference, to be sent in the same manner to this group by 31st December 2019, wherein the selection shall be done through auditions, the date of which shall be intimated soon.

Towards the making of GPSC Souvenir, the Case studies or Essays written originally by the Member Principals or their teachers on the theme, need to be sent to Dr Indu Khetrapal, Principal, Salwan Public School and Ms. Anita Makkar, Principal, The HDFC School, Gurugram by 6th January 2020. These will also feature in the GPSC Souvenir.
8. There being no other point in the agenda, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks extended by Ms. Alka Singh, Principal, Blue Bells Public School, Sector-10, Gurugram.
