It was attended by 22 members


Proceedings

1. The Chairperson Ms. Aparna Erry after ascertaining the quorum commenced the meeting by welcoming all the esteemed members. She complimented all the members for the success of five Webinars held consecutively, starting from 29th May 2020 right up to 26th June 2020. She thanked the members for their extended cooperation in selection of the versatile & potential speakers.
2. Minutes of the all the webinars held during the lockdown period were ratified and approved.
3. As per circulated agenda, Ms Aditi Misra, Principal, DPS, Sector 45, Gurgaon, gave her suggestions that from within GPSC, some member Principals could get together and hold panel discussions on topic like Reopening of Schools, Art Integration in Curriculum, College Admissions, Outcome based education etc. The Chairperson, Ms Aparna Erry, really liked the suggestion, and asked the members to feel free to suggest names of prospective speakers also, so that more Webinars/Panel Discussions could be conducted.

Dr Indu Khetarpal, Principal, Salwan School, suggested that the Book on Parenting written by Dr Marmar Mukopadhyay, could be given to each school to keep in its library, for reference, and GPSC could fund it too. She read out the balance from the GPSC's Annual Accounts Summary and said that GPSC was quite comfortable with its funds regulations. She also suggested that schools could get in touch with our webinar speaker Dileep Mukerjee's for conducting teacher's and student's workshops. The Chairperson, welcomed the suggestions.
5. The Chairperson reminded the members regarding the yearly subscription for GPSC that was due to be paid. It was proposed by Dr Anshu Arora, Principal, Amity International School, Sector 43, Gurugram, in pandemic conditions, GPSC should show some considerations for the subscription fees. The Chairperson requested Ms Arti Chopra, Principal, Amity International School, Sector 46, to conduct an on-line live poll to get the consensus from all the members. Ms Chopra instantly conducted an on-line poll, giving three options to members, of 100% subscription, 50% subscription and 25% subscription fees. The option of 50% of Annual subscriptions payment got maximum votes. All the members gave their consent to implement the poll results. The Chairperson announced that instead of Rs 10,000, this year member schools shall pay only Rs 5000 towards the annual subscription fees of GPSC.
6. Mr. Vaibhav Kapoor, Principal, Ajanta, Public School, Gurugram suggested that this year, the on-line conference of GPSC schools should also be held on line. The Chairperson liked the suggestion and added that a discussion could be held in the next meeting as well.

7. Ms Nirmal Yadav, Director & Principal, CCA school, Gurugram proposed , that articles/case studies written by Member Principals could be collated , and once published, it could be released on the GPSC's Annual Conference. The Chairperson and other members really liked the suggestion.
8. The Secretary, MsArti Chopra reminded the members to fill the MS Form shared on the link<https://tinyurl.com/y7xb8avt>, in a bid to update the GPSC Calendar for session 2020-21. The members were requested to complete their entries within three days.
9. There being no other matter, the meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks, proposed by Ms Aparna Erry, Principal, DAV School, Sector 14, Gurugram to the members.
