

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The highlights of the Proceedings were as follows:

2. The Minutes of the meeting held on 30 October 2020 were ratified and approved.
3.  - The conference will aim to explore how teachers deal with societal changes that have created new contexts for teaching, with increasingly diverse classrooms in schools.
 - The theme of the Conference would be:

Sub themes:

 - Assessing skills in a changing landscape
 - Social and Emotional Learning: Creating Supportive Learning Environments for All

 - Beyond COVID-19: Embracing the new normalThe members were asked to suggest names of speakers, to the Chairperson Ms Aparna Erry or Secretary Ms Arti Chopra over mail.

Moving ahead with the circulated agenda, it was proposed by the Secretary Ms. Arti Chopra that members could contribute articles, case studies and the best practice; based on the sub themes mentioned. They could be written by the school heads as well their teachers and an e-chronicle could be released on the day of the conference, comprising of contributions from all the member schools.
